Dear Neighbor:

We hope you will join us, your neighbors, community leaders, local businesses and others as we review revised plans for Lincoln Yards at an upcoming community meeting:

Thursday, November 29th at 6:00 p.m. Park Community Church / Renew Chicago 1001 N. Crosby Street – Auditorium Parking is available immediately north of the building in a surface lot. An ADAaccessible elevator, and limited internal parking is available in the garage adjacent to the main entrance.

Lincoln Yards is a proposed commercial and residential development that would spur significant investment in neighborhood infrastructure, roads, bridges, open space and parks. It also would enable environmental clean-up and restoration for a large area that has suffered neglect and the negative effects of more than a century of heavy industrial use. The project would create unprecedented economic benefits for the city, create tens of thousands of jobs and generate tens of millions of dollars in tax revenue for public services annually. Our original vision for the site was introduced at a community meeting in July 2018. On November 29th, we will present an updated version of the proposal, which incorporates feedback we have received from residents, community leaders, city officials and other important stakeholders over the last six months.
